They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths.” This suggests a departure from true faith and a rise in false teachings within the church.

Conclusion

While these signs may cause fear or uncertainty, Christians are encouraged to remain steadfast in their faith and vigilant in their watchfulness. As Jesus said in Matthew 24:42, “Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come.”
