It is important to surround yourself with other Christian couples who can encourage, pray for, and provide wisdom and guidance when needed. The Bible says in Ecclesiastes 4:9-10, “Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up.”
