Christ's return marks the ultimate victory over sin, death, and Satan. Revelation 19:11-16 (NIV) describes Jesus' triumphant return: "With justice he judges and wages war. His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns. He has a name written on him that no one knows but he himself. He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God."

Gathering of Believers

The Second Coming will unite believers from every corner of the earth, as stated in Matthew 24:31 (NIV): "And he will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other."
