The exorcism usually involves a combination of prayer, reciting passages from the Bible, and fasting. The exorcist must be careful to not cause any harm to the person being exorcised.

But I believe that you died for my sins and rose again. I ask that you come into my heart and be my Lord. I commit to following you and living for you every day.
