4. Fear of Death

The fear of death can be a major source of fear in our lives. We may be afraid of death because we don't know what comes after it. In the Bible, we are reminded that death is not the end, but rather a new beginning. John 11:25-26 says, "Jesus said to her, 'I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he dies, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die.'"
