Evangelising to Atheists in Christianity

Romans 1:16 – “For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.”

2 Timothy 2:24-25 – “And the Lord’s servant must not be quarrelsome but must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth.”

John 3:16 – “For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that

whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.”

Romans 10:9 – “If you declare with your mouth, ‘Jesus is Lord,’ and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.”

Ephesians 2:8-9 – “For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast.”

Matthew 7:7 – “Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.”

John 14:6 – “Jesus answered, ‘I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.’”

It is important to remember that it is ultimately up to the individual to accept Jesus as their Savior. Pray for guidance and wisdom on how to share the gospel with others, and trust in God’s plan for their life.

When evangelizing to an atheist, it is important to approach the conversation with kindness, respect, and an open mind. It’s also important to be prepared to answer questions and provide reasons for your beliefs, while also recognizing that you may not convince them to believe in God. Ultimately, the decision to believe in God is a personal one that each individual must make on their own.
