II. In the New Testament

In the New Testament, the name of God is usually referred to as "God" or "Lord". However, there are a few instances where Yahweh is used to refer to God. In the book of Matthew, Yahweh is used to refer to God when Jesus is baptized in the Jordan River. In the book of Mark, Yahweh is used to refer to God when Jesus is transfigured on the mountain.
