The Book of Revelation is the last book of the Bible and is filled with prophecies about the coming of Christ. that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.” This prophecy is a reference to the coming of Christ as the King of Kings and Lord of Lords, who will come to judge the world and bring justice to the nations.

The third prophecy in the Book of Revelation is found in Revelation 22:12-13, which states, “And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.” This prophecy is a reference to the coming of Christ as the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, who will come to reward the faithful and punish the wicked.

And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.” This prophecy is a reference to the coming of Christ as the King of the New Jerusalem, who will bring peace and joy to the world.
