How the name Jehovah Tsidkenu is fulfilled in Jesus Christ

Jehovah Tsidkenu is a Hebrew name for God that means "The Lord Our Righteousness". It is a title of God that is found in the Old Testament of the Bible and is used to describe how God provides righteousness to His people. In Revelation 19:11, it says, "And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war." This verse speaks of Jesus as the one who will judge the world in righteousness and who will bring salvation to all who believe in Him.
