### 4. Seek Wise Counsel

We can also seek wise counsel from other believers. We can ask them for advice and insight into the Bible and into our lives. We can also ask them to pray for us and to help us understand God's will for our lives.

### 5. Obey God

The final step in applying revelation knowledge is to obey God. We must be willing to follow His commands and to live according to His will. We must also be willing to accept the consequences of our actions.

And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. (Colossians 3:17)
