How to Evangelise?

Prayer

"And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us. And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of him." (1 John 5:14-15)

Humility

When evangelising, it is important to show humility and respect for the person you are speaking to. Remember that it is not about you, but about introducing them to the love of God. Speak with gentleness and understanding and be sure to listen more than you talk.

"Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person." (Colossians 4:6)

The Gospel

When you are evangelising, it is important to focus on the gospel message. Share with your audience the good news of Jesus' death and resurrection and how through His death and resurrection we can be reconciled to God. Invite them to make a decision to put their faith in Jesus and be saved.

"For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures." (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

Salvation Prayers: Dear Lord Jesus, I come to you today acknowledging my need for salvation. I confess that I have sinned and fallen short of your glory. But I believe that you died for my sins and rose again. I ask that you come into my heart and be my Lord. I commit to following you and living for you every day. Thank you for your love and for the gift of eternal life. In your name I pray, Amen.
