
How to use the name Jehovah Saboath to pray

Jehovah Sabaoth is a powerful name of God that is used in prayer in the Christian faith. It is derived from the Hebrew phrase “Yahweh Sabaoth” which means “Lord of Hosts” or “Lord of Armies”. This name is used to invoke the power of God in prayer and to remind us of His sovereignty and protection. In the Bible, this name is used to refer to God’s power and authority over all of creation.

In the Old Testament, the name Jehovah Sabaoth is used to refer to God’s power and authority over the armies of Israel. In the book of Joshua, for example, the Lord says to Joshua, “Be strong and courageous, for you shall cause this people to inherit the land that I swore to their fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous, being careful to do according to all the law that Moses my servant commanded you. Do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may have good success wherever you go. This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.” (Joshua 1:6-9).

In the New Testament, the name Jehovah Sabaoth is used to refer to God’s power and authority over the Church. In the book of Revelation, for example, the Lord says to the Church, “Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my recompense with me, to repay everyone for what he has done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end.” (Revelation 22:12-13).

Salvation Prayers : Dear Lord Jesus, I come to you today acknowledging my need for salvation. I confess that I have sinned and fallen short of your glory. But I believe that you died for my sins and rose again. I ask that you come into my heart and be my Lord. I commit to following you and living for you every day. Thank you for your love and for the gift of eternal life. In your name I pray, Amen.
