The Bible celebrates the beauty of physical intimacy within marriage (1 Corinthians 7:3-5) while emphasizing the importance of sexual purity before marriage (1 Thessalonians 4:3-5). God calls couples to honor their bodies as temples of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:18-20).

Cultivating a Christ-Centered Marriage

A successful marriage is built upon a foundation of faith in Christ. Couples are encouraged to pray together, study God's Word, and seek counsel from mature believers (Proverbs 15:22). By keeping Christ at the center of their relationship, couples can experience deep spiritual intimacy and grow together in God's love.
