The New Testament is the second part of the Bible and consists of 27 books. It tells the story of Jesus Christ and his teachings. It also outlines the spread of the early church and the growth of Christianity.

The main themes of the New Testament are love, faith, and hope. One of the most famous passages in the New Testament is found in John 3:16:

â??For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.â?•
