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Pastoral care and counseling in promoting healing in Christianity

In Romans 12:2, Paul writes, “Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.” This passage reminds us that we should strive to renew our minds and hearts, and to seek God’s will for our lives.
