Sharing Evidence of Salvation

The Bible is clear that salvation is a gift from God that is available to all who believe in Jesus Christ. heart and be my Lord. I commit to following you and living for you every day.

In Romans 5:1-2, Paul writes, "Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God." This passage shows us that salvation brings us joy and hope, and that we can stand firm in the grace of God.
