Sharing the Gospel with Others

We are also told in Romans 10:14-15, "How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: 'How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!'" This verse reminds us that it is our responsibility to share the gospel with others.

When sharing the gospel with others, it is important to remember that it is not our job to convince them to believe. We are simply called to share the message and let the Holy Spirit do the work of convicting and drawing people to Christ. We must also remember to be respectful and loving when sharing the gospel. We should never be judgmental or pushy, but instead show love and compassion.

Salvation Prayers : Dear Lord Jesus, I come to you today acknowledging my need for salvation. I confess that I have sinned and fallen short of your glory. But I believe that you died for my sins and rose again. I ask that you come into my heart and be my Lord. I commit to following you and living for you every day.
