Q: How does the Holy Spirit help believers to be prepared for heaven?

A: The Holy Spirit helps believers to be prepared for heaven by giving them life in their mortal bodies. In Romans 8:11, Paul says, “And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you.”
