And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged by what was written in the books, according to what they had done. And the sea gave up the dead who were in it, Death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them, and they were judged, each one of them, according to what they had done."

The judgment of the wicked will be based on their deeds and their actions in life. Those who have done good will be rewarded with eternal life in the kingdom of God, while those who have done evil will be condemned to eternal punishment. The Bible also speaks of the judgment of the wicked in other passages, such as Isaiah 66:24, which says, "And they shall go out and look on the dead bodies of the men who have rebelled against me. For their worm shall not die, their fire shall not be quenched, and they shall be an abhorrence to all flesh."
