The Qualifications of an Apostle in Christianity

The Bible is clear about the qualifications of an apostle in Christianity. According to the Bible, an apostle must be a witness of the resurrection of Jesus Christ, be called by God, and be sent by Jesus Christ.

Acts 1:21-22 says, â??Therefore, of these men who have accompanied us all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us, beginning from the baptism of John to that day when He was taken up from us, one of these must become a witness with us of His resurrection.â?•

The Bible also states that an apostle must be called by God. In Acts 13:2-3, it says, \hat{a} ?? As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, \hat{a} ? Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them. \hat{a} ? Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away. \hat{a} ?

Finally, an apostle must be sent by Jesus Christ. In John 20:21, Jesus said, â??As the Father has sent Me, I also send you.â?•

1 Corinthians 4:2, it says, â?? Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful.â?• An apostle must also be a teacher of the gospel. In 2 Timothy 2:2, it says, â?? And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.â?•
