a place of "eternal punishment" (Matthew 25:46) and "everlasting destruction" (2 Thessalonians 1:9).

The Bible is clear that all who reject God and His love will go to Hell. Jesus said, "Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son" (John 3:18).

The purpose of Hell is to punish those who have rejected God and His love. It is a place of judgment and justice, where the wicked will be punished for their sins. The Bible says, "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23).

The only way to avoid Hell is to accept God's free gift of salvation through Jesus Christ. Jesus said, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me" (John 14:6). By believing in Jesus and accepting His death on the cross for our sins, we can be saved from the punishment of Hell.

VI. What Does the Bible Say About Hell?

The Bible speaks of Hell as a place of "outer darkness" (Matthew 8:12) and "everlasting fire" (Matthew 25:41). It is a place of "eternal punishment" (Matthew 25:46) and "everlasting destruction" (2 Thessalonians 1:9). The Bible also speaks of Hell as a place of "weeping and gnashing of teeth" (Matthew 13:42) and "torment" (Revelation 14:11).

Salvation Prayers : Dear Lord Jesus, I come to you today acknowledging my need for salvation. I confess that I have sinned and fallen short of your glory. But I believe that you died for my sins and rose again. I ask that you come into my heart and be my Lord. I commit to following you and living for you every day. Thank you for your love and for the gift of eternal life. In your name I pray, Amen.

VII. What is the Difference Between Hell and Hades?

The terms Hell and Hades are often used interchangeably in the Bible, but they are not the same. Hades is the temporary place of the dead, where all people go when they die, both the righteous and the wicked. Hell is the permanent place of punishment for the wicked, where they will suffer for eternity.
